VOTING INFORMATION

ETT is conducting two elections in which you may vote for Table Officers and Executive Officers.

Election 1 –TABLE OFFICERS
Monday, April 25, 9:00 a.m. to
Wednesday, April 27, 10:00 p.m.

- Vote for three positions:
 - President
 - Vice President
 - Secretary/Treasurer

Election 2 –EXECUTIVE OFFICERS
Wednesday, May 4, 9:00 a.m. to
Monday, May 9, 10:00 p.m.


- Vote for up to 11 Executive Officers

HOW DO I VOTE?

YOU VOTE ONLINE THROUGH OUR VOTING SERVICE PROVIDER, SIMPLY VOTING

- Using your ETFO Number and password (see box below), log in at ett.simplyvoting.com
- Cast your ballot for each position following the instructions on your screen.
- Confirm your ballot selections.
- If you should be interrupted while voting, at any point before you confirm your ballot, you may re-access the voting system later to restart the voting process.

WHERE CAN I GET HELP?

- You **MUST** have your ETFO number  to vote. If you do not have your ETFO number, you may obtain it by contacting the ETFO office – **Member Records at 416-962-3836** on weekdays during the business hours of 8 a.m. – 5 p.m.
- If you have your ETFO number and still require assistance in accessing the voting system, this support is available through the electronic Voter Help Centre: ett.ca/votersupport
- The electronic Voter Help Centre is only accessible with an ETFO number. It is limited to having Simply Voting issue to you, via email, a new password, PROVIDED THAT NO ONE HAS ALREADY VOTED IN THE PENDING ELECTION USING THAT PASSWORD. The email address to which the new password will be sent can **ONLY** be one that you have previously registered with ETT. **Requests received after 12 noon on a final day of voting may not get a response in time to vote that day.** Once the new password is issued, the previously-issued password will be disabled. If your voting difficulty is not resolved in this manner, please email the full details of your concern to the Chief Returning Officer at ettcro22@gmail.com. Please understand that responding is a manual process to ensure security and it may not be possible to answer within a matter of a few hours. **This is a very good reason to vote early, if you are able.**

CANDIDATE INFORMATION

- For candidate information please refer to the enclosed Candidate Information Booklet or go to the Member Portal on the ETT website at www.ett.ca, and select the “ETT Executive Elections 2022” icon at the left of your screen.

- **SAVE THE PASSWORD THAT WILL COME TO YOU BY CANADA POST MAIL ON THE HARD COPY VERSION OF THIS DOCUMENT; it is required to vote in each election.**
- A password is provided for the personal use only of the authorized voter to whom it is sent. It must not be shared with, or used by, anyone other than that authorized voter.
- Voting is only available during the stated time periods and **closes at 10:00 p.m. sharp** on each final voting day. You are encouraged to vote early in order to avoid higher volume activity as the end of the voting period approaches.
