Biography: This workshop will be led by Frances Greenidge, a teacher on Disability Leave who was injured in a workplace accident in 2009 and a subsequent motor vehicle accident in 2011. A passionate and vibrant individual who saw a sharp and long-lasting loss of earnings, physical and cognitive function, and emotional vitality as a result of her injuries, Frances fought through the resulting complexity of dealing with a number of personnel and agencies relevant to submitting and resolving post-injury claims for benefits and compensation. Frances' tenacity and perseverance can serve to inform and reassure teachers that there is a trusted system in place to provide guidance and support for navigating the challenge of workplace injury benefit claims if they are injured while on duty.
