

Honorary Life Award

This award may be given to two ETT members who will have retired by June 30, 2024. The recipient(s) of the Honorary Life Award shall have a \$200.00 donation made in their name to a school or accredited charitable organization of the recipient(s) choice. The recipient(s) of the Honorary Life Award shall be recognized at the Annual Dinner.

Criteria:

The **ETT Honorary Life Award** may be granted to an individual who:

- a) will be retiring, or has retired (to a maximum of one year after retirement) from the education profession;
- b) has provided outstanding leadership and service to the Local during their career in activities that may include, but are not limited to the following: Executive Officer, Regional Organizer, Union Steward, Committee Member, ETT Representative (Board Committee), Delegate (ETFO AM), ETFO Provincial Standing Committee;
- c) has demonstrated high standards of personal and professional ethics; and
- d) is a selfless advocate of the objects and goals of ETT.
