Criteria:

The **Union Steward Award** may be granted to a current member of ETT who:

- a) is a member in good standing of Elementary Teachers of Toronto;
- b) has provided outstanding leadership and service (at the Local level) as Union Steward during the 2023-2024 school year;
- c) has demonstrated high standards of personal and professional ethics;
- d) is a selfless advocate of the objects and goals of ETT; and
- e) has actively encouraged members to get involved in ETT
